



Denver Center for International Studies (DCIS) 2017-18 SchoolChoice Priorities

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the Round One SchoolChoice student assignment process.

Note: No particular type of applicant is guaranteed admission.

Applicants for grades 6 – 8 are prioritized in the following way:

1. Students who are currently attending DCIS Fairmont in 5th grade **and** have a sibling currently attending DCIS
2. District resident students with a currently-attending sibling
3. Students who are currently attending DCIS Fairmont in 5th grade
4. Children of the school's founding or board members, if applicable, or full-time employees of the school
5. All other District resident students
6. Non-District resident students with a currently-attending sibling
7. All other non-District resident students

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice form must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
