



DSST: Green Valley Ranch Middle and High School 2017-18 SchoolChoice Priorities

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the Round One SchoolChoice student assignment process.

Applicants for grades 6 – 12 are prioritized in the following way:

Note: No particular type of applicant is guaranteed admission.

Note: 65% of total capacity is set aside for students who qualify for Free or Reduced Lunch (FRL). If there are not enough FRL applicants to fill these seats, the seats will remain unfilled. If there are more FRL applicants than available seats, those FRL applicants will be considered for the remaining 35% of seats, with a lower priority.

1. Children of the school's founding board members, if applicable, or full-time employees of the school
2. District or non-District resident students with a sibling who is currently attending the school
3. Students residing in the Far Northeast Enrollment Zone in the Green Valley Ranch or Singletree neighborhoods (80249) – 75% of available seats
4. Students residing in the Far Northeast Enrollment Zone in the Montbello neighborhood (80239) – 25% of available seats
5. All other District resident students
6. All other non-District resident students

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice form must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
