

STRIVE Prep: Federal Middle School 2017-18 SchoolChoice Priorities

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the Round One SchoolChoice student assignment process.

Applicants for grades 6 – 8 are prioritized in the following way:

- 1. Children of the school's founding or board members, if applicable, or full-time employees of the school
- 2. District or non-District resident students with a currently-attending sibling
- 3. District or non-District resident students with a sibling who is an alumnus of the school
- 4. Students who reside in the Southwest Middle School enrollment zone
- 5. Students who are currently attending another STRIVE campus
- 6. Students who reside in the West Middle School enrollment zone
- 7. All other District resident students
- 8. All other non-District resident students

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice form must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
