



Charter Schools 2018-19 SchoolChoice Priorities

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants for select charter schools during the Round One SchoolChoice student assignment process.

All applicants are prioritized in the following way:

Note: No particular type of applicant is guaranteed admission.

1. Children of full-time employees of the school
2. District or non-District resident students with a currently-attending sibling at GALS or the Boys School of Denver
3. District or non-District resident students with a sibling who is an alumnus of GALS or the Boys School of Denver
4. District resident students who qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) program
5. District resident students who are currently impacted by school closure decisions
6. All other District resident students
7. Non-District resident students who qualify for the FRL program
8. All other non-District resident students

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice form must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
