



STRIVE Prep: Federal Middle School 2018-19 SchoolChoice Priorities

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the Round One SchoolChoice student assignment process.

Applicants for grades 6 – 8 are prioritized in the following way:

1. Children of full-time employees of the school
2. District or non-District resident students with a currently-attending sibling
3. District or non-District resident students with a sibling who is an alumnus of the school
4. Students who reside in the Southwest Middle School enrollment zone
5. Students who are currently attending another STRIVE campus school
6. Students who reside in the West Middle School enrollment zone
7. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
8. All other District resident students
9. All other non-District resident students

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice form must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
