



Extended Elementary Schools 2018-19 SchoolChoice Priorities

The following information will be used to prioritize middle school applicants for extended elementary schools during the 2017-18 Round One SchoolChoice student assignment process.

Applicants for grades 6 – 8 are prioritized in the following way:

Note: No particular type of applicant is guaranteed admission.

1. Students who reside in the school boundary and are currently attending the school (not a guarantee)
2. District resident students who are currently attending the school
3. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school
4. Students who qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) program with a currently-attending sibling
5. District resident students with a currently-attending sibling
6. Children of full-time employees at the school
7. District resident students who qualify for the FRL program
8. District resident students impacted by school closure decisions
9. All other District resident students
10. Non-District resident students with a currently-attending sibling
11. All other non-District resident students

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice form must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
