The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the Round One SchoolChoice student assignment process.

Applicants for ECE-3 are prioritized in the following way:

Note: There is no guarantee for ECE enrollment in Denver Public Schools.

1. Students who reside in the Archuleta, DCIS Ford or Greenwood school boundaries
2. Students who reside in far northeast Denver
3. Children of full-time employees at the school
4. All other District resident students
5. All other non-District resident students

Applicants for ECE-4 are prioritized in the following way:

Note: There is no guarantee for ECE enrollment in Denver Public Schools.

1. Students who reside in the Archuleta, DCIS Ford, Greenwood or Maxwell school boundaries who are currently attending the school
2. Students who reside in the Archuleta, DCIS Ford, Greenwood or Maxwell school boundaries
3. Students who reside in far northeast Denver that are currently attending the school
4. Students who reside in far northeast Denver
5. Children of full-time employees at the school
6. District resident students who are currently attending the school
7. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
8. All other District resident students
9. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school
10. All other non-District resident students



Applicants for Archuleta and Greenwood Kindergarten (located at Escalante-Biggs) are prioritized in the following way:

1. Students who reside in the school boundary with a currently attending sibling
2. District resident students with a currently-attending sibling
3. Children of full-time employees at the school
4. District resident students who are currently attending the school
5. Students who reside in the Archuleta priority zone
6. Students who reside in the Gateway zone
7. Students who are currently attending a closed school
8. Students who reside in the 80239 zip code
9. All other Denver resident students
10. Non-District residents who are currently attending
11. Non-District residents with a currently attending sibling
12. All other non-District resident students

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice form must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
