

Far Northeast Enrollment Zone Florida Pitt Waller SchoolChoice Priorities

The following information will be used to prioritize middle school applicants for extended elementary school enrollment in an Enrollment Zone, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

Applicants for grades 6 – 8 are prioritized in the following way:

- 1. Children of full-time employees of the school
- 2. Students who reside in the enrollment zone with a currently-attending sibling
- 3. Students residing in the enrollment zone who are currently attending the school
- 4. Students who reside in the enrollment zone
- 5. District resident students with a currently-attending sibling
- 6. District resident students who are currently attending the school
- 7. District resident students impacted by school closure decisions
- 8. All other District resident students
- Non-District resident students with a currently-attending sibling
- 10. Non-District resident students currently attending the school
- 11. All other non-District resident students

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice form must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
