



## **Enrollment Zone Schools 2018-19 SchoolChoice Priorities**

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants for enrollment zone schools during the 2018-19 Round One SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

### **Applicants for ECE are prioritized in the following way (if applicable):**

*Note: There is no guarantee for ECE enrollment in Denver Public Schools.*

1. Students who reside in the enrollment zone with a currently-attending sibling
2. Students who reside in the enrollment zone and are currently attending the school's ECE program
3. Children of a full-time employee of the school
4. Students who reside in the school's proximity zone
5. Students who reside in the enrollment zone
6. Greater Park Hill/Stapleton resident students with a currently-attending sibling
7. Greater Park Hill/Stapleton resident students currently attending the school
8. Greater park Hill/Stapleton resident students who qualifies for the Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) program
9. Greater Park Hill/Stapleton resident students
10. District resident students with a currently-attending sibling
11. District resident students who are currently attending the school's ECE program
12. All other District resident students
13. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school's ECE program
14. Non-District residents who have a currently-attending sibling
15. All other non-District resident students

**Applicants for Kindergarten are prioritized in the following way:** *\*Note: Within each of the following priority groupings, a weighted preference is provided for students who qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) program to achieve a 25% FRL rate in Kinder.*



1. Students who reside in the enrollment zone with a currently-attending sibling
2. Students who reside in the enrollment zone and are currently attending the school's ECE program
3. Children of a full-time employee of the school
4. Students who reside in the school's proximity zone
5. Students who reside in the enrollment zone
6. Greater Park Hill/Stapleton resident students with a currently-attending sibling
7. Greater Park Hill/Stapleton resident students currently attending the school
8. Greater park Hill/Stapleton resident students who qualifies for the Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) program
9. Greater Park Hill/Stapleton resident students
10. District resident students with a currently-attending sibling
11. District resident students who are currently attending the school's ECE program
12. All other District resident students
13. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school's ECE program
14. Non-District residents who have a currently-attending sibling
15. All other non-District resident students

**Applicants for grades 1 – 5 are prioritized in the following way:**

1. Children of full-time employees of the school
2. Students who reside in the enrollment zone with a currently-attending sibling
3. Students who reside in the school's priority zone
4. Students who reside in the enrollment zone
5. District resident students with a currently-attending sibling
6. All other District resident students
7. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school or have a currently-attending sibling
8. All other non-District resident students



*Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice form must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.*
