



Gifted Magnet Elementary School Programs 2017-18 SchoolChoice Priorities

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants for the Gifted Magnet (formerly HGT) program during the 2017-18 Round One SchoolChoice student assignment process.

Qualified applicants are prioritized in the following way:

Note: Only students identified by the District as eligible for the Gifted Magnet program will be considered.

1. Students who reside in the school boundary (guaranteed) **or** District resident students who are currently attending the school
2. Students eligible for the Gifted Magnet program who reside in the Gifted Magnet feeder school zone with a currently-attending sibling (see chart below)
3. Students eligible for the Gifted Magnet program who reside in the District with a currently-attending sibling
4. Students eligible for the Gifted Magnet program who reside in the Gifted Magnet feeder school zone (see chart below)
5. District resident students with a currently-attending sibling
6. Students eligible for the Gifted Magnet program who reside in the district
7. Children of full-time employees at the school
8. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
9. All other District resident students
10. Non-District resident students eligible for the Gifted Magnet program with a currently-attending sibling
11. Non-District resident students eligible for the Gifted Magnet program
12. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school **or** have a currently-attending sibling
13. All other non-District resident students
