Non-Boundary School

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

All applicants are prioritized in the following way:

Note: No particular type of applicant is guaranteed admission.

1. Children of full-time employees of the school
2. District or non-District resident students with a sibling admitted at GALS or the Boys School of Denver
3. District or non-District resident students with sibling who is the alumnus of GALS or the Boys School of Denver
4. District resident students that qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) program
5. District resident students impacted by school closure decisions
6. All other District resident students
7. Non-District resident students that qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) program
8. All other non-District resident students

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice application must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
