

Cheltenham Elementary 2019-20 SchoolChoice Priorities Neighborhood Boundary School

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

Applicants for ECE are prioritized in the following way (if applicable):

Note: There is no guarantee for ECE enrollment in Denver Public Schools.

- 1. Students who reside in the school boundary with a sibling admitted at the school
- 2. Students who reside in the school boundary and are currently attending the school's ECE program
- 3. Children of full-time employees at the school
- 4. Students who reside in the school boundary and qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) program
- 5. Students who reside in the school boundary
- 6. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
- 7. District resident students who are currently attending the school's ECE program
- 8. All other District resident students
- 9. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school's ECE program or have a sibling admitted at the school
- 10. All other non-District resident students

Applicants for Kindergarten are prioritized in the following way:

- 1. Students who reside in the school boundary (guaranteed in Round 1 only)
- 2. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
- 3. Children of full-time employees at the school
- 4. District resident students who are currently attending the school's 4-year-old ECE program
- 5. District residents currently impacted by school closure decisions
- 6. All other District resident students
- 7. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school's 4-year-old ECE program **or** have a sibling admitted at the school
- 8. All other non-District resident students



Applicants for grades 1 – 5 are prioritized in the following way:

- Students who reside in the school boundary (guaranteed in Round 1 only) or
 District resident students who are currently attending the school
- 2. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
- 3. Children of full-time employees at the school
- 4. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
- 5. All other District resident students
- 6. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school <u>or</u> have a sibling admitted at the school
- 7. All other non-District resident students

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice application must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
