2019-20 SchoolChoice Priorities
Enrollment Zone School (6-8)

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

Applicants for grades 6 – 8 are prioritized in the following way:

1. Children of full-time employees of the school
2. Students residing in the Far Northeast enrollment zone who are currently attending the school **and** have a sibling admitted at the school
3. Students residing in the Far Northeast enrollment zone who are currently attending the school **or** have a sibling admitted at the school
4. Students who reside in the Far Northeast enrollment zone
5. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
6. District resident students who are currently attending the school
7. District resident students impacted by school closure decisions
8. All other District resident students
9. Non-District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
10. Non-District resident students currently attending the school
11. All other non-District resident students

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice application must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
