



**STRIVE Prep: SMART High School
2019-20 SchoolChoice Priorities
Non-Boundary School**

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the Round One SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

All applicants are prioritized in the following way:

1. Children of full-time employees of the school
2. District or non-District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
3. District or non-District resident students with a sibling who is an alumnus of the school
4. Students who are currently attending STRIVE Prep: Federal or STRIVE Prep: Westwood
5. Students who are currently attending any other STRIVE campus
6. Students who reside in Southwest Denver
7. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
8. All other District resident students
9. All other non-District resident students

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice form must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
