The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

Pre-qualified applicants are prioritized in the following way:

Note: Only students whose primary language is pre-qualified by Academia Ana Marie Sandoval will be considered. Contact the school at 720-424-4370 for more information. No particular type of applicant is guaranteed admission.

Applicants for grades ECE are prioritized in the following way:

1. District or non-District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
2. Children of full-time employees of the school
3. Students who reside in the Beach Court, Brown, Centennial, Columbian, Edison or Trevista school boundaries and qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) program
4. Students who reside in the Beach Court, Brown, Centennial, Columbian, Edison or Trevista school boundaries
5. District students that qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) program
6. All other District resident students
7. All other non-District resident students

Applicants for grades 1 – 5 are prioritized in the following way:

1. District or non-District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
2. Children of full-time employees of the school
3. Students that reside in the Beach Court, Brown, Centennial, Columbian, Edison or Trevista school boundaries and have previously attended a Montessori school
4. District resident students that have previously attended a Montessori school
5. Students who reside in the Beach Court, Brown, Centennial, Columbian, Edison or Trevista school boundaries and qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) program
6. Students who reside in the Beach Court, Brown, Centennial, Columbian, Edison or Trevista school boundaries



7. All other District resident students
8. All other non-District resident students

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice application must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
