2019-20 SchoolChoice Priorities
Non-Boundary School (6-8)

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

Applicants for grades 6 – 8 are prioritized in the following way:

Note: No particular type of applicant is guaranteed admission.

1. Students who reside in the school boundary and are currently attending the school (not a guarantee)
2. District resident students who are currently attending the school
3. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school
4. District resident students who qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) program and have a sibling admitted at the school
5. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
6. Children of full-time employees at the school
7. District resident students who qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) program
8. District resident students impacted by school closure decisions
9. All other District resident students
10. Non-District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
11. All other non-District resident students

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice application must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
