Neighborhood Boundary Schools

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

Applicants for ECE are prioritized in the following way (if applicable):

Note: There is no guarantee for ECE enrollment in Denver Public Schools.

1. Students who reside in the school boundary with a sibling admitted at the school
2. Students who reside in the school boundary and are currently attending the school's ECE program
3. Students who reside in the school boundary
4. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
5. Children of a full-time employee at the school
6. District resident students who are currently attending the school's ECE program
7. District resident students that qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) program
8. All other District resident students
9. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school's ECE program or have a sibling admitted at the school
10. All other non-District resident students

Applicants for Kindergarten are prioritized in the following way:

1. Students who reside in the school boundary (guaranteed in Round 1 only)
2. District resident students that qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) program with a sibling admitted at the school
3. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
4. Children of a full-time employee at the school
5. District resident students who are currently attending the school and qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) program
6. District resident students who are currently attending the school
7. District resident students who qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) program
8. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
9. All other District resident students
10. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school's 4-year-old ECE program or have a sibling admitted at the school
11. All other non-District resident students



Applicants for grades 1 – 5 are prioritized in the following way:

1. Students who reside in the school boundary (guaranteed in Round 1 only) or District resident students who are currently attending the school
2. Students eligible for the Gifted Magnet program who reside in the Gifted Magnet feeder school zone with a sibling admitted at the school (see chart below)
3. Students eligible for the Gifted Magnet program who reside in the District with a sibling admitted at the school
4. Students eligible for the Gifted Magnet program who reside in the Gifted Magnet feeder school zone (see chart below) and qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) program.
5. Students eligible for the Gifted Magnet program who reside in the Gifted Magnet feeder school zone (see chart below)
6. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
7. Students eligible for the Gifted Magnet program who reside in the district
8. Children of full-time employees at the school
9. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
10. District resident students who qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) program.
11. All other District resident students
12. Non-District resident students eligible for the Gifted Magnet program with a sibling admitted at the school
13. Non-District resident students eligible for the Gifted Magnet program
14. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school or have a sibling admitted at the school
15. All other non-District resident students
