



Gifted Magnet Elementary School Programs 2019-20 SchoolChoice Priorities

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

Qualified applicants are prioritized in the following way:

Note: Only students identified by the District as eligible for the Gifted Magnet program will be considered.

1. Students who reside in the Gifted Magnet feeder school zone with a sibling admitted at the school
2. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
3. Students who reside in the Gifted Magnet feeder school zone (see below)
4. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
5. All other District resident students
6. Non-District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
7. All other non-District resident students
