



**Stedman Elementary Spanish Immersion
2019-20 SchoolChoice Priorities
Qualifying Program**

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

Note: Within each priority tier, students who qualify for the Free or Reduced Price Lunch program are prioritized, followed by students who speak Spanish at home.

Applicants for ECE are prioritized in the following way (if applicable):

Note: There is no guarantee for ECE enrollment in Denver Public Schools.

1. Students who are currently attending the Spanish Immersion program (guaranteed unless the student is accepted via Choice into a new school)
2. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
3. Children of full-time employees at the school
4. Students who reside in the school boundary and qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) program
5. Students who reside in the school boundary
6. District resident students that qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) program
7. District resident students who are currently attending the school's traditional ECE program
8. All other District resident students
9. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school's ECE program or have a sibling admitted at the school
10. All other non-District resident students

Applicants for K-5 are prioritized in the following way:

Please note that applicants for grades 2 through 4 must be Spanish qualified. Contact the school with any questions.

1. Students who are currently attending the ECE Spanish Immersion program (guaranteed in Round 1 only)
2. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
3. Children of full-time employees at the school
4. Students who reside in the school boundary that qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) program
5. Students who reside in the school boundary



6. District resident students who qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) program
7. District resident students who are currently attending the school's traditional ECE program
8. District resident students impacted by school closure decisions
9. All other District resident students
10. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school's 4-year-old ECE program or have a sibling admitted at the school
11. All other non-District resident students

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice application must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
