Enrollment Zone Schools

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

Applicants for ECE are prioritized in the following way (if applicable):

Note: There is no guarantee for ECE enrollment in Denver Public Schools.

1. Students who reside in the enrollment zone with a sibling admitted at the school
2. Students who reside in the enrollment zone and are currently attending the school's ECE program
3. Children of a full-time employee of the school
4. Students who reside in a geographic area within the enrollment zone with a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
5. Students who reside in the school's proximity zone**
6. Students who reside in the enrollment zone**
7. Greater Park Hill/Stapleton resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
8. Greater Park Hill/Stapleton resident students currently attending the school
9. Students who reside in a geographic area within Greater Park Hill/Stapleton that has a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
10. Greater Park Hill/Stapleton resident students
11. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
12. District resident students who are currently attending the school
13. District resident students who reside in a geographic area with a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
14. All other District resident students
15. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school
16. Non-District residents who have a sibling admitted at the school
17. All other non-District resident students

Applicants for Kindergarten are prioritized in the following way:

1. Students who reside in the enrollment zone with a sibling admitted at the school



2. Students who reside in the enrollment zone and are currently attending the school
3. Children of full-time employees at the school
4. Students who reside in a geographic area within the proximity zone with a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
5. Students who reside in the school's proximity zone**
6. Students who reside in a geographic area within the enrollment zone with a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
7. Students who reside in the enrollment zone**
8. District resident students who reside in a geographic area with a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch.
9. Students who reside in Greater Park Hill/Stapleton and have a sibling admitted at the school
10. Students who reside in Greater Park Hill/Stapleton and are currently attending the school
11. Students who reside in a geographic area within Greater Park Hill/Stapleton that has a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
12. Students who reside in Greater Park Hill/Stapleton
13. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
14. District resident students who are currently attending the school
15. All other District resident students
16. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school
17. Non-District resident students who have a sibling admitted at the school
18. All other non-District resident students

*** ECE and Kinder: During Round 1, 25% of available seats (after siblings, currently attending students, and children of FTEs are placed) are for proximity zone students. The remaining 75% of available seats are for the entire enrollment zone.*

Applicants for grades 1-5 are prioritized in the following way:

1. Children of full-time employees of the school
2. Students who reside in the enrollment zone with a sibling admitted at the school
3. Students who reside in a geographic area within the proximity zone with a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
4. Students who reside in the school's proximity zone



5. Students who reside in a geographic area within the enrollment zone with a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
6. Students who reside in the enrollment zone and are impacted by school closure decisions
7. Students who reside in the enrollment zone
8. Students who reside in Greater Park Hill/Stapleton and have a sibling admitted at the school
9. Students who reside in Greater Park Hill/Stapleton and are currently attending the school
10. Students who reside in a geographic area within Greater Park Hill/Stapleton that has a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
11. Students who reside in Greater Park Hill/Stapleton
12. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
13. District resident students currently attending the school
14. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
15. All other District resident students
16. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school
17. Non-District resident students that have a sibling admitted at the school
18. All other non-District resident students

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice application must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
