2020-21 SchoolChoice Priorities
Neighborhood Boundary School

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

Applicants for grades 9 – 12 are prioritized in the following way:

1. Students who reside in the school boundary (guaranteed in Round 1 only)
2. District resident students who are currently attending the school
3. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
4. Children of full-time employees at the school
5. Students residing in the Far Northeast enrollment zone
6. Students who reside in a geographic area within the Greater Park Hill Stapleton Middle School Zone that has a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
7. District resident students who reside in a geographic area with a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
8. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
9. All other District resident students
10. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school **or** have a currently-attending sibling
11. All other non-District resident students

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice application must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.



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
