The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

Applicants for ECE-3 are prioritized in the following way:

Note: There is no guarantee for ECE enrollment in Denver Public Schools.

1. Students who reside in the Castro, CMS or Munroe school boundaries with a sibling admitted at the ECE center
2. Students who reside in the Castro, CMS or Munroe school boundaries
3. Children of full-time employees at the school
4. All other District resident students
5. All other non-District resident students

Applicants for ECE-4 are prioritized in the following way:

Note: There is no guarantee for ECE enrollment in Denver Public Schools.

1. Students who reside in the Castro, CMS or Munroe school boundaries with a sibling admitted at the ECE center
2. Students who reside in the Castro, CMS or Munroe school boundaries who are currently attending the school
3. Students who reside in the Castro, CMS or Munroe school boundaries
4. Children of full-time employees at the school
5. District resident students who have a sibling admitted at the ECE center
6. District resident students who are currently attending the school
7. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
8. All other District resident students
9. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school
10. All other non-District resident students



Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice application must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
