The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

All applicants for grade ECE-Immersion Spanish are prioritized in the following way:

1. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school who reside in a geographic area with a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
2. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
3. Children of full-time employees of the school who reside in a geographic area with a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
4. Children of full-time employees of the school
5. Students who reside in the school boundary where there is a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
6. District resident students who reside in a geographic area with a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
7. Students who reside in the school boundary
8. District resident students who are currently attending the school's non-immersion Spanish ECE program
9. All other District resident students
10. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school's non-immersion program or have a sibling admitted at the school
11. All other non-District resident students

All applicants for grades K-5-Immersion Spanish are prioritized in the following way:

1. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school who reside in a geographic area with a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
2. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
3. Children of full-time employees of the school who reside in a geographic area with a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
4. Children of full-time employees of the school
5. Students who reside in the school boundary where there is a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch



6. District resident students who reside in a geographic area with a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
7. District resident students who currently attend the school's non-immersion Spanish program
8. Students who reside in the school boundary
9. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
10. All other District resident students
11. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school's non-immersion program or have a sibling admitted at the school
12. All other non-District resident students

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice application must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
