



## **The Boys School of Denver (BOYS) 2020-21 SchoolChoice Priorities Non-Boundary School**

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

**All applicants for grades 6-8 are prioritized in the following way:**

*Note: No particular type of applicant is guaranteed admission.*

1. Children of full-time employees of the school
2. District or non-District resident students with a sibling admitted at GALS or the Boys School of Denver
3. District or non-District resident students with a sibling who is the alumnus of GALS or the Boys School of Denver
4. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
5. District resident students who reside in a geographic area with a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
6. All other District resident students
7. Non-District resident students who reside in a geographic area with a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
8. All other non-District resident students

*Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice application must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.*
