The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

All applicants for grade ECE3 are prioritized in the following way:

Note: No particular type of applicant is guaranteed admission.

1. Children of full-time employees of the school
2. Students who reside in the Archuleta, DCIS Ford or Greenwood school boundaries with a sibling admitted at the ECE Center
3. Students who reside in the Archuleta, DCIS Ford or Greenwood school boundaries
4. Students who reside in far northeast Denver
5. All other District resident students
6. All other non-District resident students

All applicants for grade ECE4 are prioritized in the following way:

Note: No particular type of applicant is guaranteed admission.

1. Children of full-time employees of the school
2. Students who reside in the Archuleta, DCIS Ford or Greenwood school boundaries with a sibling admitted at the ECE Center
3. Students who reside in the Archuleta, DCIS Ford, Greenwood or Maxwell school boundaries who are currently attending the school
4. Students who reside in the Archuleta, DCIS Ford, Greenwood or Maxwell school boundaries
5. Students who reside in Far Northeast Denver that are currently attending the school
6. Students who reside in Far Northeast Denver
7. District resident students who are currently attending the school
8. All other District resident students
9. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school
10. All other non-District resident students

All applicants for grade K are prioritized in the following way:

Note: No particular type of applicant is guaranteed admission.

1. Children of full-time employees of the school
2. Students who reside in the enrollment zone with a sibling admitted at the school



3. Students who reside in the enrollment zone and are currently attending the school
4. Students who reside in the school's proximity zone
5. Students who reside in the enrollment zone
6. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
7. District resident students who are currently attending the school
8. Students who reside in the 80239 zip code
9. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
10. All other District resident students
11. Non-District resident students who have a sibling admitted at the school
12. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school
13. All other non-District resident students

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice application must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
