The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the Round One SchoolChoice student assignment process.

**Applicants for ECE-3 are prioritized in the following way:**

*Note: There is no guarantee for ECE enrollment in Denver Public Schools.*

1. Students who reside in the Asbury, Cory, Lincoln, Slavens, Steele or University Park school boundaries with a sibling admitted at the ECE center
2. Students who reside in a geographic area within the Asbury, Cory, Lincoln, Slavens, Steele, or University Park school boundaries that has a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
3. Students who reside in the Asbury, Cory, Lincoln, Slavens, Steele or University Park school boundaries
4. Children of full-time employees at the school
5. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the ECE center
6. District resident students who reside in a geographic area that has a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
7. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
8. All other District resident students
9. All other non-District resident students

**Applicants for ECE-4 are prioritized in the following way:**

*Note: There is no guarantee for ECE enrollment in Denver Public Schools.*

1. Students who reside in the Asbury, Cory, Lincoln, Slavens, Steele or University Park school boundaries with a sibling admitted at the ECE center
2. Students who reside in the Asbury, Cory, Lincoln, Slavens, Steele or University Park school boundaries who are currently attending the school
3. Students who reside in a geographic area within the Asbury, Cory, Lincoln, Slavens, Steele, or University Park school boundaries that has a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
4. Students who reside in the Asbury, Cory, Lincoln, Slavens, Steele or University Park school boundaries



5. Children of full-time employees at the school
6. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the ECE center
7. District resident students who reside in a geographic area that has a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch and are currently attending the school
8. District resident students who are currently attending the school
9. District resident students who reside in a geographic area that has a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch District resident students impacted by school closure decisions
10. All other District resident students
11. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school
12. All other non-District resident students

**Applicants for Cory Kindergarten (located at Stephen Knight) are prioritized in the following way:**

1. Students who reside in the Cory school boundary (guaranteed in Round 1 only)
2. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school (Cory only)
3. Children of full-time employees at the school
4. District resident students who are currently attending the school's 4-year-old ECE program
5. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
6. All other District resident students
7. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school's 4-year-old ECE program **or** have a sibling admitted at the school
8. All other non-District resident students

*Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice application must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.*
