



McAuliffe International School 2020-21 SchoolChoice Priorities Enrollment Zone School

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

All applicants for grades 6-8 are prioritized in the following way:

Note: No particular type of applicant is guaranteed admission.

1. District resident students who are currently attending the school
2. Children of full-time employees of the school
3. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
4. Students currently impacted by school closure decisions and who reside in the enrollment zone
5. Students who reside in the enrollment zone where there is a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
6. Students who reside in the enrollment zone
7. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
8. District resident students who reside in a geographic area that has a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
9. All other District resident students
10. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school or have a sibling admitted at the school
11. All other non-District resident students

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice application must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
