



## **Academia Ana Marie Sandoval 2023-24 SchoolChoice Priorities Non-Boundary School**

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

**Please note that ECE-4 will not be using the DPS SchoolChoice lottery system this year. All applicants to ECE-4 at this school should apply via the Universal Preschool (UPK) site. **All applicants for grade ECE-3 are prioritized in the following way:**

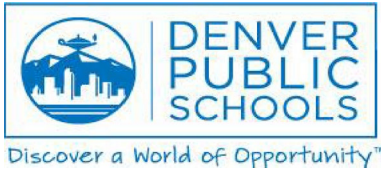
1. District or non-District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
2. Children of employees of the school (recipients of this priority cannot work at multiple schools)
3. Students who reside in the Beach Court, Brown, Centennial, Columbian, Edison or Trevista school boundaries who are currently attending the school
4. Students who reside in the Beach Court, Brown, Centennial, Columbian, Edison or Trevista school boundaries where there is a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
5. Students who reside in the Beach Court, Brown, Centennial, Columbian, Edison or Trevista school boundaries
6. District resident students who reside are currently attending the school
7. District resident students who reside in a geographic area with a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
8. All other District resident students
9. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school
10. All other non-District resident students

***Note: If your student is currently attending Academia Ana Marie Sandoval - ECE-3, they will automatically be enrolled in Academia Ana Marie Sandoval - ECE-4 for the next school year unless the student participates in the SchoolChoice process and is subsequently accepted to another school.***

**All applicants for grade K are prioritized in the following way:**

1. District or non-District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
2. Children of employees of the school (recipients of this priority cannot work at multiple schools)



3. Students that reside in the Beach Court, Brown, Centennial, Columbian, Edison or Trevista school boundaries and have previously attended a Montessori school
4. District resident students who have previously attended a Montessori School
5. Students who reside in the Beach Court, Brown, Centennial, Columbian, Edison or Trevista school boundaries that are currently attending the school
6. Students who reside in the Beach Court, Brown, Centennial, Columbian, Edison or Trevista school boundaries where there is a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
7. Students who reside in the Beach Court, Brown, Centennial, Columbian, Edison or Trevista school boundaries
8. District resident students who are currently attending the school
9. All other District resident students
10. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school
11. All other non-District resident students

***Note: If your student is currently attending Academia Ana Marie Sandoval - ECE 4, they will automatically be enrolled in Academia Ana Marie Sandoval for the next school year unless the student participates in the SchoolChoice process and is subsequently accepted to another school.***

**All applicants for grades 1-6 are prioritized in the following way:**

1. District or non-District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
2. Children of employees of the school (recipients of this priority cannot work at multiple schools)
3. Students that reside in the Beach Court, Brown, Centennial, Columbian, Edison or Trevista school boundaries and have previously attended a Montessori school
4. District resident students who have previously attended a Montessori School
5. Students who reside in the Beach Court, Brown, Centennial, Columbian, Edison or Trevista school boundaries where there is a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
6. Students who reside in the Beach Court, Brown, Centennial, Columbian, Edison or Trevista school boundaries currently impacted by school closure decisions
7. Students who reside in the Beach Court, Brown, Centennial, Columbian, Edison or Trevista school boundaries
8. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
9. All other District resident students
10. Non-District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
11. All other non-District resident students
