



**DSST: Byers High School
2023-24 SchoolChoice Priorities
Non-Boundary School**

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

All applicants for grades 9-12 are prioritized in the following way:

Note: No particular type of applicant is guaranteed admission.

1. Children of full-time employees of the school
2. District or non-District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
3. District resident students who reside in a geographic area with a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
4. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
5. All other District resident students
6. Non-District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
7. All other non-District resident students

Note: If your student is currently attending DSST: Byers Middle School, they will automatically be enrolled in DSST: Byers High School for the next school year unless the student participates in the SchoolChoice process and is subsequently accepted to another school.

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice application must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
