Non-Boundary School

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

All applicants for grades K-8 are prioritized in the following way:

Note: No particular type of applicant is guaranteed admission.

1. Children of employees of the school (recipients of this priority cannot work at multiple schools)
2. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
3. Non-District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
4. District or Non-District resident students with a sibling who is an alumnus of the school
5. Students who reside in the Mayfair Park priority zone
6. District resident students who reside in a geographic area with a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
7. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions*
8. All other District resident students
9. Non-District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions*
10. All other non-District resident students

*This admission priority is only applicable to grades 1-8.

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice application must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
