



## **Downtown Denver Expeditionary School 2023-24 SchoolChoice Priorities Non-Boundary School**

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

**All applicants for grades K-5 are prioritized in the following way:**

*Note: No particular type of applicant is guaranteed admission.*

1. Children of employees of the school (recipients of this priority cannot work at multiple schools)
2. District or non-District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
3. Students who reside in the Greater Five Points enrollment zone, Columbine, Dora Moore, Garden Place, International Academy of Denver or Center for Talent Development at Greenlee school boundaries and who reside in a geographic area with a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
4. Students who reside in the Greater Five Points enrollment zone, Columbine, Dora Moore, Garden Place, International Academy of Denver or Center for Talent Development at Greenlee school boundaries currently impacted by school closure decisions\*
5. Students who reside in the Greater Five Points enrollment zone, Columbine, Dora Moore, Garden Place, International Academy of Denver or Center for Talent Development at Greenlee school boundaries
6. District resident students who reside in a geographic area with a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
7. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions\*
8. All other District resident students
9. Non-District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions\*
10. All other non-District resident students

*\*This admission priority is only applicable to grades 1-5.*

*Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice application must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.*
