The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

Please note that ECE-4 will not be using the DPS SchoolChoice lottery system this year. All applicants to ECE-4 at this school should apply via the Universal Preschool (UPK) site. 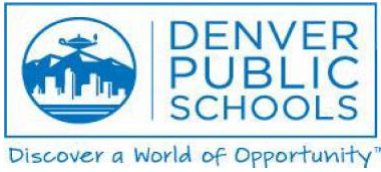
All applicants for grade K are prioritized in the following way:

Note: No particular type of applicant is guaranteed admission.

1. Students who reside in the school boundary (guaranteed in Round 1 only)
2. District resident students who reside in a geographic area with a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch and have a sibling admitted at the school
3. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
4. Children of employees of the school (recipients of this priority cannot work at multiple schools)
5. District resident students who reside in a geographic area with a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch and are currently attending the school's 4-year-old ECE program
6. District resident students who are currently attending the school's 4-year-old ECE program
7. District resident students who reside in a geographic area with a high concentration of students eligible for free and reduced price lunch
8. All other District resident students
9. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school's 4-year-old ECE program or have a sibling admitted at the school
10. All other non-District resident students

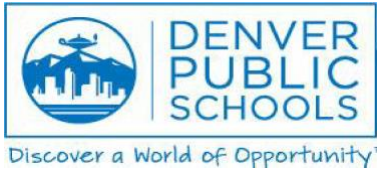
Applicants for grades 1 – 5 are prioritized in the following way:

1. Students who reside in the school boundary (guaranteed in Round 1 only) or District resident students who are currently attending the school
2. Students eligible for the Highly Gifted and Talented program who reside in the Highly Gifted and Talented feeder school zone with a sibling admitted at the school (see chart below)
3. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school



4. Children of employees of the school (recipients of this priority cannot work at multiple schools)
5. Students eligible for the Highly Gifted and Talented program who reside in the District with a sibling admitted at the school
6. Students eligible for the Highly Gifted and Talented program who reside in the Highly Gifted and Talented feeder school zone (see chart below) and qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) program.
7. Students eligible for the Highly Gifted and Talented program who reside in the Highly Gifted and Talented feeder school zone (see chart below)
8. Students eligible for the Highly Gifted and Talented program who reside in the district
9. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
10. District resident students who qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch (FRL) program.
11. All other District resident students
12. Non-District resident students eligible for the Highly Gifted and Talented program with a sibling admitted at the school
13. Non-District resident students eligible for the Highly Gifted and Talented program
14. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school or have a sibling admitted at the school
15. Non-District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
16. All other non-District resident students
