Non-Boundary School**

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

All applicants for grades K-8 are prioritized in the following way:

Note: No particular type of applicant is guaranteed admission.

1. Children of employees of the school (recipients of this priority cannot work at multiple schools)
2. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
3. Non-District resident students who have a sibling admitted at the school
4. District or non-District resident students currently attending the school
5. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions*
6. All other District resident students
7. Non-District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions*
8. All other non-District resident students

**This admission priority is only applicable to grades 1-8.*

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice application must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
