All applicants for grades 6-8 are prioritized in the following way:

Note: No particular type of applicant is guaranteed admission.

1. District resident students who are currently attending the school
2. Children of employees of the school (recipients of this priority cannot work at multiple schools)
3. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
4. Students who reside in Southwest Middle School enrollment zone or the West Middle School enrollment zone currently impacted by school closure decisions
5. Students who reside in Southwest Middle School enrollment zone or the West Middle School enrollment zone
6. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
7. All other District resident students
8. Non-district resident students who are currently attending the school
9. Non-District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
10. Non-District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
11. All other Non-District resident students
