



Rocky Mountain Prep Creekside 2023-24 SchoolChoice Priorities Non-Boundary School

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

Please note that ECE-4 will not be using the DPS SchoolChoice lottery system this year. All applicants to ECE-4 at this school should apply via the Universal Preschool (UPK) site. All applicants for grades ECE-3 are prioritized in the following way:

Note: No particular type of applicant is guaranteed admission.

1. Children of employees of the school (recipients of this priority cannot work at multiple schools)
2. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school or with a sibling who is an alumnus of the school
3. Non-District resident students who have a sibling admitted at the school
4. District resident students who are currently attending the school
5. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school
6. All other District resident students
7. All other non-District resident students

Note: If your student is currently attending Rocky Mountain Prep: Creekside ECE-3, they will automatically be enrolled in Rocky Mountain Prep: Creekside ECE-4 for the next school year unless the student participates in the SchoolChoice process and is subsequently accepted to another school.

All applicants for grade K are prioritized in the following way:

Note: No particular type of applicant is guaranteed admission.

1. Children of employees of the school (recipients of this priority cannot work at multiple schools)
2. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school or with a sibling who is an alumnus of the school
3. Non-District resident students who have a sibling admitted at the school
4. District resident students who are currently attending the school's 4-year-old ECE program
5. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school's 4-year-old ECE program
6. All other District resident students
7. All other non-District resident students



Note: If your student is currently attending Rocky Mountain Prep: Creekside ECE-4, they will automatically be enrolled in Rocky Mountain Prep: Creekside for the next school year unless the student participates in the SchoolChoice process and is subsequently accepted to another school.

All applicants for grades 1-5 are prioritized in the following way:

Note: No particular type of applicant is guaranteed admission.

1. Children of employees of the school (recipients of this priority cannot work at multiple schools)
2. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school or with a sibling who is an alumnus of the school
3. Non-District resident students who have a sibling admitted at the school
4. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
5. All other District resident students
6. Non-District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
7. All other non-District resident students

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice application must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
