



**STRIVE Prep - Federal
2023-24 SchoolChoice Priorities
Enrollment Zone School**

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

All applicants for grades 6-8 are prioritized in the following way:

Note: No particular type of applicant is guaranteed admission.

1. Children of employees of the school (recipients of this priority cannot work at multiple schools)
2. District or non-District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
3. Students who reside in the Southwest Middle School enrollment zone currently impacted by school closure decisions
4. Students who are currently attending another STRIVE Prep or Rocky Mountain Prep campus in Denver
5. Students who reside in the Southwest Middle School enrollment zone
6. Students who reside in the West Middle School enrollment zone currently impacted by school closure decisions
7. Students who reside in the West Middle School enrollment zone
8. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
9. All other District resident students
10. Non-District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
11. All other non-District resident students

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice application must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
