



**STRIVE Prep: Ruby Hill Elementary School  
2023-24 SchoolChoice Priorities  
Non-Boundary School**

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

**Applicants for grades K – 5 are prioritized in the following way:**

1. Children of employees of the school (recipients of this priority cannot work at multiple schools)
2. District or non-District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
3. District or non-District resident students with a sibling who is an alumnus of the school
4. Students who are currently attending another STRIVE Prep or Rocky Mountain Prep campus in Denver
5. District resident students impacted by school closure decisions\*
6. All other District resident students
7. Non-District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions\*
8. All other non-District resident students

*\*This admission priority is only applicable to grades 1-5.*

*Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice application must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.*
