Non-Boundary School**

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

All applicants for grades 9-12 are prioritized in the following way:

Note: No particular type of applicant is guaranteed admission.

1. Children of employees of the school (recipients of this priority cannot work at multiple schools)
2. District or non-District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
3. Students who are an alumnus of STRIVE Prep - Ruby Hill who are currently attending STRIVE Prep - Federal, STRIVE Prep - Kepner or STRIVE Prep - Westwood
4. Students who are currently attending STRIVE Prep - Federal, STRIVE Prep - Kepner or STRIVE Prep - Westwood
5. Students who are currently attending any other STRIVE Prep campus
6. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
7. Students who reside in Southwest Denver
8. All other District resident students
9. Non-District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
10. All other non-District resident students

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice application must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
