Enrollment Zone School

The following information will be used to prioritize applicants during the SchoolChoice student assignment process, as approved by the DPS Board of Education.

All applicants for grades 6-8 are prioritized in the following way:

Note: No particular type of applicant is guaranteed admission.

1. District resident students who are currently attending the school
2. Children of employees of the school (recipients of this priority cannot work at multiple schools)
3. Students who reside in the West Middle School enrollment zone with a sibling admitted at the school
4. Students who reside in the West Middle School enrollment zone currently impacted by school closure decisions
5. Students who reside in the West Middle School enrollment zone
6. District resident students with a sibling admitted at the school
7. Students who reside in the Southwest Middle School enrollment zone currently impacted by school closure decisions
8. Students who reside in the Southwest Middle School enrollment zone
9. District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
10. All other District resident students
11. Non-District resident students who are currently attending the school or have a sibling admitted at the school
12. Non-District resident students currently impacted by school closure decisions
13. All other non-District resident students

Denver Public Schools makes every attempt to accommodate siblings who apply together in the same school year. A separate SchoolChoice application must be submitted for each sibling to be considered.
